

## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR EMERITUS STATUS

The following will be verified:

- (1) Applicant held an Independent Practice certificate of registration, a General licence under Part III of the Health Disciplines Act, or the equivalent licence under a predecessor of that Act, or some combination of them, continuously for 25 years.
- (2) Applicant has not been the subject of a finding of professional misconduct or incompetence that has been entered in the register.
- (3) At the time of application for Emeritus Status, the applicant is not,
  - (a) in default of payment of any fees prescribed by the regulations;
  - (b) in default of providing to the College any information required by or under an Act or regulation;
  - (c) the subject of proceedings for professional misconduct or incompetence.
- (4) Applicant is fully retired from the practice of medicine in Ontario, and elsewhere, and has resigned his or her membership in the College.

Note: In cases where the applicant does not comply with 1 or 2 above, the Registration Committee may still grant Emeritus Status provided the applicant complies with 3 and 4 above.
