

Pathway for RCPSC Practice Eligibility Route (PER) Candidates

You may be eligible under this pathway if you have:



An acceptable medical degree

Obtained the Licentiate of the Medical Council of Canada (LMCC) or successfully completed an <u>acceptable qualifying examination</u>

Been accepted into <u>RCPSC's Practice Eligibility Route</u>.

ICENCE

Restricted certificate of registration to practice under supervision at a specified location

• Valid for up to three years while you complete RCPSC's time-in-practice requirements and successfully complete the RCPSC certification exam.

You may apply for an **Independent Practice certificate** of registration once you have:

Completed all RCPSC exams
Fulfilled RCPSC time-in-practice requirements
Obtained RCPSC certification.

You may also be eligible for **Specialty Recognition** under the <u>CPSO Specialist Recognition Criteria in Ontario</u> policy.
