

Code of Conduct for Board Meeting Observers

- This Code of Conduct applies to members of the public (referred to as "Observers") who wish to attend CPSO Board of Director (Board) meetings in person.
- Observer attendance will be subject to a security process.
 This includes a metal detector hand wand search by Security personnel and examination of bags, backpacks, purses and/or anything contained in pockets as deemed necessary or appropriate by Security personnel.
- A guest badge will be provided once you have undergone the security process.
- Observers can only observe the meeting and cannot participate.
- Observers may only attend the public portions of the Board meeting.
- Observers are not permitted to bring signs or any other distracting materials, take pictures or record video or digital audio at any time while on the premises, including at the meeting.
- Prior to leaving the building, Observers are asked to return to the Front Desk staff with their guest badge to sign out. Upon re-entering the building, the security process referenced above will be followed with each re-entry.
- Observers who fail to comply with this Code of Conduct may be asked to leave the meeting and the premises and may be denied re-entry to the meeting.
